Water

Activity C1

This activity is a very important introduction to the theme of 'water'. It also introduces the pupils to the water cycle. It then progresses to encouraging the pupils to think about wasting/saving water.

Activity C2

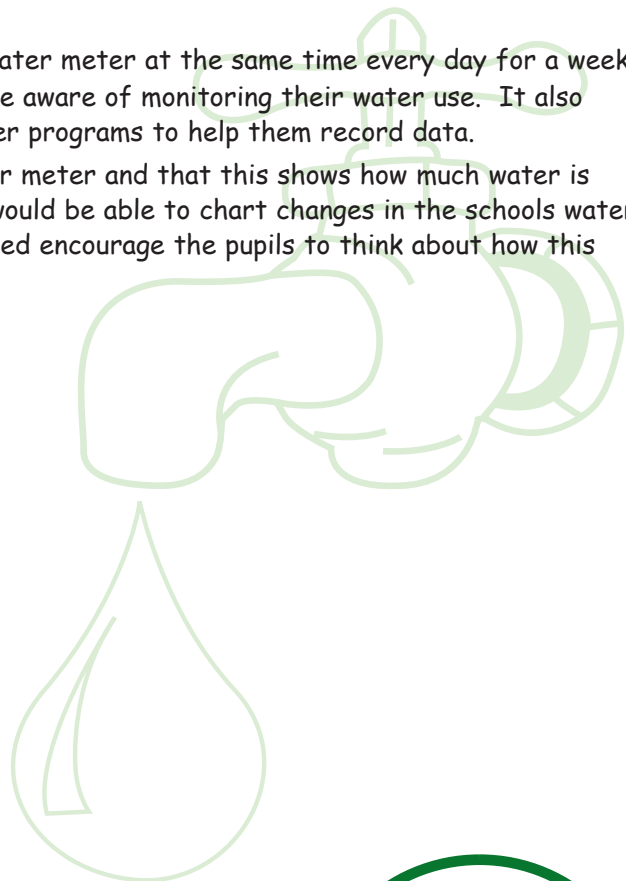
This practical activity encourages the pupil to become aware of the school environment and the subject of transporting water. It is a very good activity to be using in conjunction with raising awareness of other countries. It would be useful if the student could be given a basic plan of the school and they will need to be able to speak to the premises officer (this part could be completed as a whole class to help with time restrictions).

The final two questions compare irrigation in England and India so background information will need to be given to the pupils.

Activity C3

This activity will require access to the school water meter at the same time every day for a week. This activity encourages the students to become aware of monitoring their water use. It also increases the pupils awareness of using computer programs to help them record data.

Explain to the pupils that the school has a water meter and that this shows how much water is being used. By writing down a daily total, they would be able to chart changes in the schools water use. After the week's activity has been completed encourage the pupils to think about how this graph will vary throughout the year.
